
## Testing for macular degeneration

- 1. Cover the left eye and look at center of the grid using your reading glasses at a comfortable reading distance.
- 2. The lines should be straight and you should be able to see the dot in the center of the grid.
- 3. Repeat the test by covering the right eye.
- 4. Distortion of the lines on the grid or blurring of the grid may be a symptom of macular degeneration.
- 5. You should be examined by your eye doctor if there is new or increased distortion or blurring of the grid.
